Academically, Leonard has achieved great success while taking many honor courses including Civics, English and Calculus. He is also actively involved in his community church where he has helped maintain the facility.


Leonard will be attending Fairmont State University where he will be pursuing a degree in Exercise Science.

Jayna Leeann Vargo


An honor graduate of Oak Hill High School, Jayna played basketball her senior year, served as Student Council class representative and was selected as a member of the National Honor Society.
